1. Manse Development Update: We have submitted our manse development plans and related documents to Brisbane City Council and their feedback is favourable. Public notification regarding the proposed development started from 23 July to 13 August 2020. There is no objection by the public and neighbouring owners. However, the City Council requested all side windows to be closed and non-operable. The acoustic engineer is in the process to discuss and resolve the matter with the City Council. Currently we have a balance of \$21,950.48 in our Future Development fund. The Church Council is aiming to raise \$500,000.00 by the 31st December 2020 for our church manse development.
